


Colorectal cancer and advanced adenoma detection rates among invited individuals in the sigmoidoscopy arm, FIT round 1, and FIT round 1-3







2. Active invitation / mailed outreach




3. Include the FIT in the invitation




4. Send a reminder letter



5. Send an advance notification



6. Involve GP (not to collect the test!)



Clear evidence

- 1. (Also) use FIT
- 2. Active invitation / mailed outreach
- 3. Include test with invitation
- 4. Send reminders
- 5. Send advance notifications
- 6. Involve GP (but not for collecting the test!)

Objectives EU-TOPIA

To systematically evaluate and quantify the harms and benefits of running programmes for breast, cervical, and colorectal cancer in all European countries, and identify ways to improve health outcomes and equity for citizens.
