The liver is an essential organ performing over 500 vital functions that include cleansing blood, eliminating toxins, transforming nutrients into energy, and storing vitamins and minerals. The two main types of primary Liver Cancer are hepatocellular carcinoma (HCC) which makes up 85 90% of all Liver Cancers, and cholangiocarcinoma (otherwise known as bile duct cancer), which accounts for about 15% of primary Liver Cancers. There are also rare types of primary Liver Cancer.
