

DiCE Operating Grants

- For both Full and Associate Member Organisations
- Unrestricted operational grants for all digestive cancer projects, activities, and campaigns (printing of educational materials, translations, equipment, etc.)
- Twice a year: spring and autumn
- Internal jury panel
- Several grants of varying amounts between 1.000€ to 2.000€
- In spring 2023, grants restricted to ECCAM campaign
- New round in autumn 2023



Who can apply

- All Member Organisations can apply, according to the previous rules
- MOs which have not received funding from DiCE in the previous years will have priority and are highly encouraged to apply.
- When there is a call for grants, don't hesitate to apply!





