HEALTH IS LOCAL

EU does not have competence to regulate (legally binding) in area of health per se. But health is regulated using another legal basis.

PRIMARY GOAL

raise awareness of the salience of digestive cancers at the national level and if deemed appropriate by MOs, adding on the perspective at the European level.

Framework for events
