

## Application for DiCE Operational Grants 2023

**Total amount:** 8.000€

**Aim:** to support Member Organisations with unrestricted operational grants for projects, activities and campaigns in their country.

There will be several grants of varying amounts between **1.000€ to 2.000€**.

**Eligibility:**

All Member Organisations are eligible to apply (Full and Associate MOs).

All digestive cancers projects will be considered.

**Purpose of award:**

- Production, printing and publishing of educational materials
- Execution of campaigns
- Technical services directly related to project outputs through local contractors, e.g. workshop facilitators, translation of materials.
- Equipment, materials and personnel services related specifically to project outputs, e.g. telephone helpline services.

**Criteria:**

The following criteria will be taken into consideration:

- Importance of the problems being solved for MOs
- Feasibility of measuring key performance indicators
- Achievability of the project
- Sustainability of the project

MOs which have not received funding from DiCE in the previous years will have priority and are highly encouraged to apply.

**Submission deadlines:**

- **October 15<sup>th</sup>**, second set of grants to be distributed mid-November (totalling 8.000€)

Grant recipients will be informed via direct mailing end of October.
